
CONCEPT: TUMOR VIRUSES


- There are many oncogenic viruses that cause _______
 - $\hfill\Box$ Some viruses integrate into the host cell genome, which can be harmful
 - □ Other viruses have proteins which interfere with normal cell functions
 - Block tumor suppressor activities
 - Interfere with cell cycle control (increase) and apoptotic (decrease) mechanisms
 - Overtake the cell replicative machinery to replicate its genome

Virus	Cancer
Hepatitis B/C	Liver cancer
Papillomavirus	Cervical cancer and head, neck, throat cancer
Herpesviruses	Kaposi's Sarcoma
Retroviruses	Kaposi's Sarcoma (AIDS)
