
## **CONCEPT: SELECTIVE MEDIA**

●Sel	ective Media: designed to pr	romote growth of the species of interest &	growth of other species.	
•	Agar:	Agar: a selective media used in the medical field to isolate gram-negative intestinal bacteria.		
	□ Contains <i>crystal</i>	to inhibit gram-positive cell growth & bile salts	which inhibits non-intestinal bacteria
