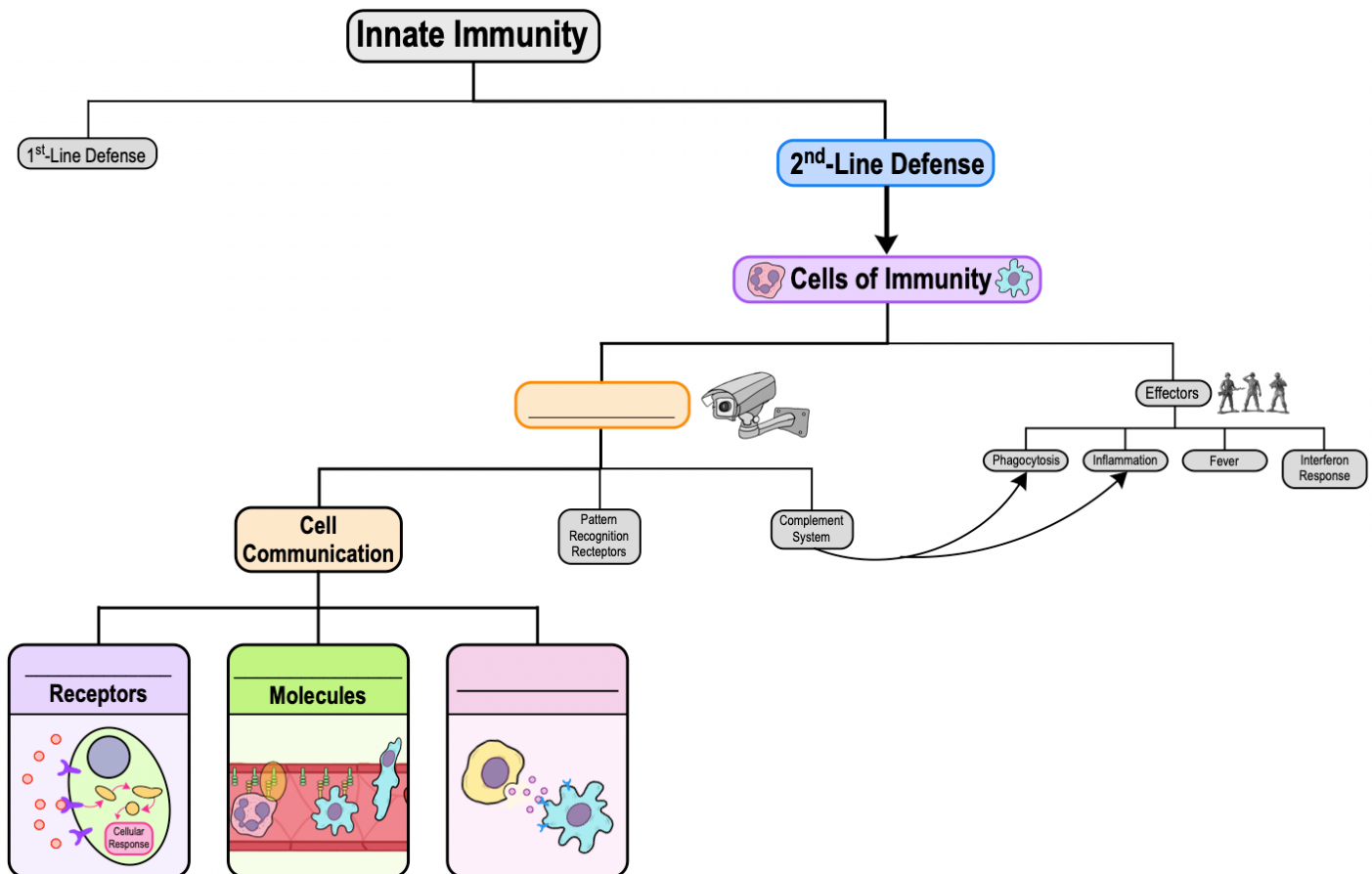


CONCEPT: INTRODUCTION TO CELL COMMUNICATION
