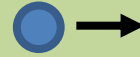


CONCEPT: MUTUAL MAGNETIC FORCE ON PARALLEL CHARGES

- Remember: Parallel currents FEEL A MUTUAL FORCE → $F =$

- Currents are just charges moving in a wire. So parallel moving charges ALSO feel a mutual Magnetic force:

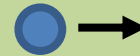
- MAGNITUDE → _____
